Govt / General Merit seats: - General Merit seats are those seats set apart for the students allotted by the Govt. following the guidelines of INC, KNMC and University.

Management seats: - Management seats are those seats set apart for the eligible candidates selected from the online applications received against the notification by the management directly based on the merit in qualifying exam and interview and following the guidelines of INC, KNMC and University.

General Information

- University Examination shall be conducted at the end of each semester.
- Internal assessment through sessional exams, Seminars, Assignments, Projects, Clinical evaluation, internal practical examination etc.
- 50% marks for the internal assessment is mandatory for appearing the University examination.

- Candidates must secure 80% attendance in theory and practical in each subject in order to appear for the University examination.
- 100% attendance in clinical practice must be acquired before the award of the degree as per Indian Nursing Council / University guidelines.
- Medium of instruction is English. Students are expected to have proficiency in English language, verbal as well as written.

II. Eligibility for Admission

1. Academic

- Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or equivalent examination recognized thereto by KUHS, Thrissur with 50% marks in physics, chemistry, biology and English put together are eligible for admission.
- Eligibility certificate:** Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from outside the state of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from the Kerala University of Health and Allied Sciences, Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview.

2. Age

- Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on 31st December of that year. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.
- Self attested copy of relevant page of school record namely S.S.L.C / ICSE/ CBSE certificate showing date of birth/ copy of birth certificate from appropriate authority should be furnished along with the application in proof of age.

III. How to Apply

1. All candidates seeking admission to B.Sc. Nursing, under Management Quota have to apply directly in the prescribed application form available in the college website **from 14.07.2025 onwards. Last date for submitting the duly filled application form is 19.07.2025 before 5pm.** Candidates should submit only one application for admission to BSc Nursing. Along with the application, all candidates have to attach a self attested copy of the mark list showing the marks in the subjects concerned in their Qualifying Examination.



3. Submission of application form through online mode only.

Applications can be submitted directly through the college website on or before the 19/07/2025 before 5pm.

IV. Selection and Admission

1. Selection of the candidates for management seats will be done in the college from among the candidates who have applied through online mode in the college website, based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination. Rank list will be published in the college website.
2. The Selected candidates will be informed of the date and time of interview and admission.
3. The Students shall pay the fees of the first year of the course at the time of admission.
4. The candidates are expected to produce the following documents in original at the time of admission.



- a) Original admit card and a copy in case of admission or Govt. seat.
- b) SSLC Certificate
- c) Aadhar card
- d) Plus Two Certificate
- e) Transfer Certificate
- f) Income Certificate
- g) Caste Certificate for candidate belonging to EWC, OBC and SC/ST Categories as per Government norms.
- h) Course and Conduct Certificate issued by the head of educational institution last attended.
- i) Hepatitis B vaccination Certificate
- j) 4 Passport size photographs.

5. If any candidate who is provisionally selected, fails to report to the Principal on or before the specified time and date, his/her selection stands automatically cancelled without any further information, and the seat will be given to the next eligible person in the rank list.

VIII. Special instruction

a. Ragging

According to the Kerala Prohibition of “ Ragging Act 1998”, ragging means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to the student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which, such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do.”
