Order No. G2/4313/2025/NC dated 20/06/2026

As per the order read 1st above, sanction was granted to the Principal, St. Joseph's College of Nursing, Dharmagiri St. Joseph's Hospital, Agustianmuzhi, Mukkom, Kozhikode to admit students to the BSc Nursing Programme during the academic year 2025-26. As per the letter read 2nd above the Principal has remitted prescribed fee for periodic inspection.

The Commission appointed by the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council inspected the institution on 07/05/2026 and submitted the report vide the read 3rd above. The inspection report was scrutinized and placed before the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council held on 19/05/2026. The Council resolved to accord sanction to admit B.Sc. Nursing students during the academic year 2026-27 vide resolution read 4th above after rectifying the deficiency. As per the letter read 5th above, the Principal submitted Compliance report.

In the above circumstances, affiliation is granted to *St. Joseph's College of Nursing, Dharmagiri St. Joseph's Hospital, Agustianmuzhi, Mukkom, Kozhikode for conducting BSc Nursing programme with an intake of 50 Students* for the academic year 2026-27 subject to the following general conditions.

General Conditions:

1. Teacher student ratio should be maintained.
2. Academic & Administrative matters shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University / Government and on the basis of the directions issued by the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be withdrawn.
3. Admission should only be made to the seats sanctioned by INC/KNMC/KUHS. If the number of intakes is reduced either by Kerala University of Health Sciences or Indian Nursing Council, the number of seats to which admission can be made should be reduced accordingly.
4. The Management is required to adhere strictly to the guidelines issued by the Government, the Indian Nursing Council and the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council for conducting the Programme.
5. The Management should obtain affiliation from the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur and suitability from Indian Nursing Council before admitting the students.
6. The Management should obtain separate order from the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council to admit the next batch of student for the academic year 2027-28.
7. The admission should strictly be in accordance with the Seat Matrix issued by Government of Kerala for the year ~~2026-27~~, failing of which, the affiliation granted will be withdrawn.
